

EVENT BULLETIN – Taekwondo Australia

Taekwondo Australia is hosting a black belt selection competition on the 18th July 2010 at the State Netball and Hockey Centre in Victoria.

This competition will be used to select National Poomsae and Sparring teams. The Australian Sparring team is targeting the British Open in September 2010.

Ranking points will be awarded to both Sparring and Poomsae athletes determined by their results at the selection competition.

Sparring athletes ranking will be used to seed their position at the upcoming National Championships.

The National Championships will be used to identify our High performance athletes and our development squad for 2010-2011.

The National Ranking System (NRS) will be used to assist selectors identify athletes for funding, future National Team selection, and Olympic pathway programs.

Full competition details including funding details will be provided in the competition info package available shortly through the Taekwondo Australia website.

The WA Sports Coaching Committee would consider arranging training sessions if there are sufficient number of athletes interested in contesting the 18th July selections event.
